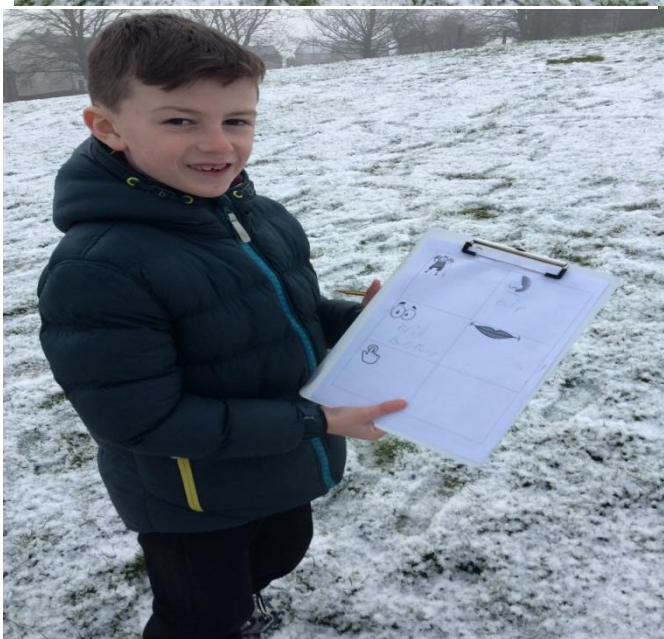


RSPB Visit – January 2019

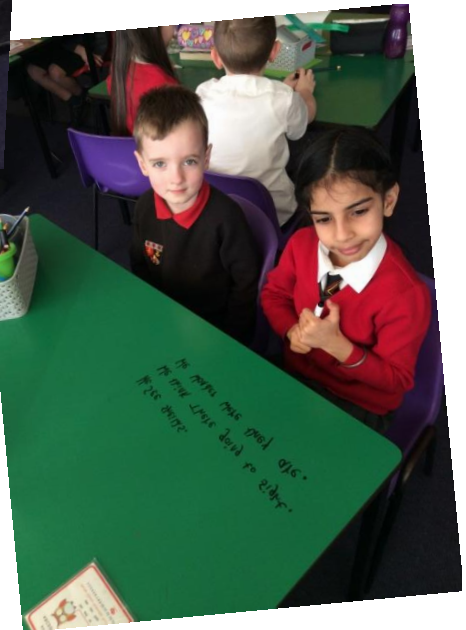






## The Romans
