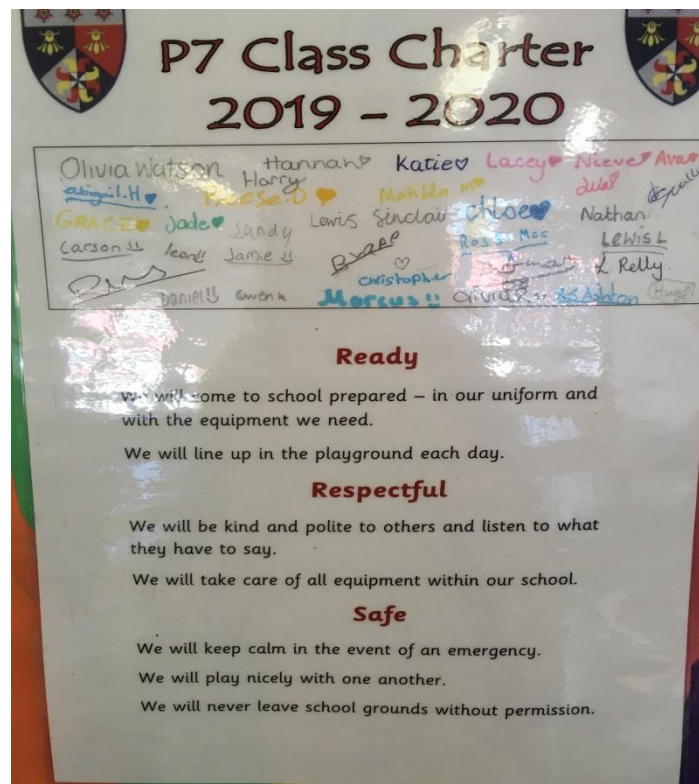


Welcome to P7!

This term we are learning about :

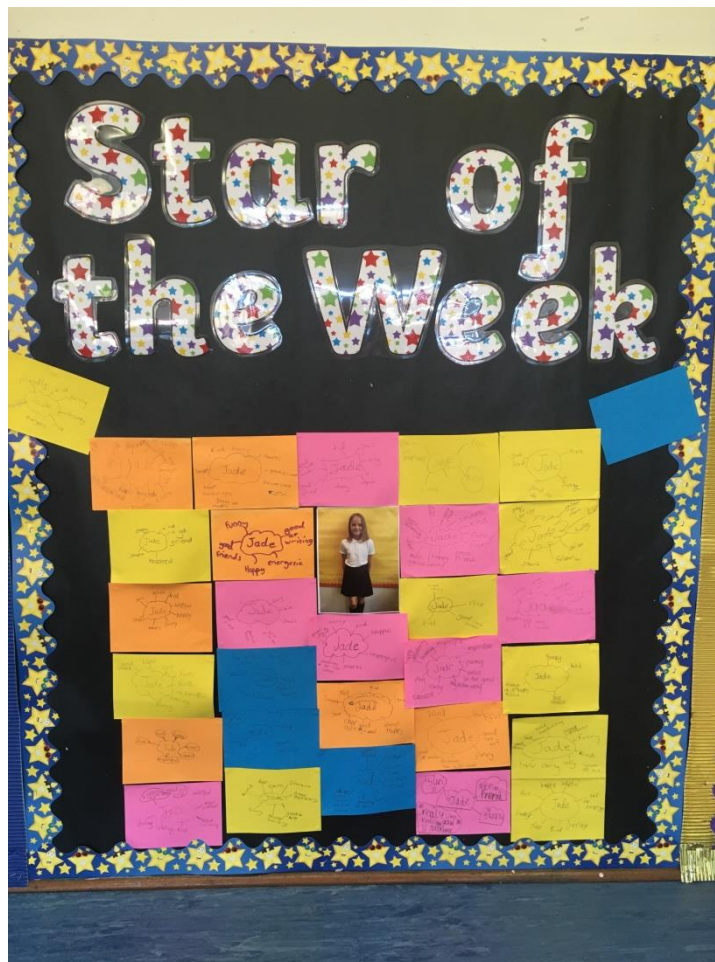
- Rights Respecting Schools- Class charter, school values

At the beginning of term we created a class charter and agreed on the importance of being ready, respectful and safe.
