In literacy this term in P3b we have been working on our spelling. We use active spelling in class. This involves writing our spellings in bubble writing and rainbow letters. We find this very engaging and enjoyable. Additionally, we have been putting our coats on and heading outside to do active spelling. We use chalk, stones, leaves and sticks to spell out our words in the playground. We love these activities and it helps us remember our spellings.
